ULTRASOUND EXAMINATION OF ABDOMEN AND PELVIS DONE.

Both kidneys are normal in location.

Right kidney measures 95 X 48 mms and shows marked changes of hydronephrosis and hydroureter due to a 11.4 mm upper ureteric calculus approx 4 cms away from pelvi ureteric Junction .

Calculus of 9.4 mm in the Upper Pole Calyx.

Calculus of 4.5 mm in the Mid Pole Calyx.

Cortico Medullary is well maintained. Renal Parenchyma appears normal.

Left kidney measures 99 X 51 mms .

Calculus of 4.8 mm in the Lower Pole Calyx.

No evidence of hydronephrosis or perinephric pathology. No obvious upper or lower ureteric calculus seen. Cortico Medullary is well maintained. Renal Parenchyma appears normal.

Urinary bladder is well distended with smooth outline with prevoid urine volume of 400 ml. No evidence of any echo reflective calculus or intrinsic bladder pathology.

Prostate is normal in size.


Liver, Gall bladder, Pancreas and Spleen are normal.

No abdominal or pelvic mass. No evidence of ascitis.

IMPRESSION

- **HYDRONEPHROTIC CHANGES IN THE RIGHT KIDNEY DUE TO AN ECHO REFLECTIVE CALCULUS OF 11.4 MM IN THE UPPER URETER APPROX 4 CMS AWAY FROM PELVI URETERIC JUNCTION .**
- **BILATERAL RENAL CALCULI AS DESCRIBED ABOVE .**
- **REST EXAMINATION OF ABDOMEN AND PELVIS IS WITHIN NORMAL LIMITS.**
